DATE	DETAILS
DAY 1	❖ <b>Depart Canada</b> and travel to Tel Aviv, Israel.
DAY 2	❖ <b>Arrive in Tel Aviv, Israel</b> and check into your hotel. [D]
DAY 3	❖ <b>Jaffa, Caesarea, Megiddo, Muhraqa</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Depart for Jaffa (Joppa), to see the house of Simon the tenor and St. Peter Church. Continue to Caesarea to visit the ancient Roman Aqua-Ducts crusader's site. Continue to Megiddo (Armageddon, found in the book of Revelation, the final battle of good and evil). Then continue to Muhraqa, the placer of sacrifice and the site where Prophet Elijah defeated the False Prophets of Ba'al. Overnight in Galilee. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 4	❖ <b>Sea of Galilee, Cana, Nazareth</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Depart to Cana, the place of the first public miracle of Jesus Christ. Here couples will renew their wedding vows. Travel to Nazareth, the place of the Annunciation and where the Holy Family lived. Visit the Church of Annunciation, a Basilica built over the house where Angel Gabriel announced the birth of Jesus to the Virgin Mary. We will celebrate Mass at the Basilica. Then we see St Joseph's workshop, Synagogue where Jesus read the Prophesies from the book of Isaiah, and Mary's Well, where daily she collected water. Return to the Galilee region for a boat ride at the Sea of Galilee, where Jesus walked on the waters. Overnight in Galilee. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 5	❖ <b>Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Capernaum, Jordan River, Bet She'an, Jerusalem</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Board the bus and drive to Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Next we travel to Tabgha, the place of the miracle of the multiplication of the fish and loaves. Next on to Capernaum, the city built on the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, it is referred to Jesus "own city", it became the center of His ministry, synagogue and St. Peter's house. Then to the Jordan River for the renewal of our baptismal promises. Continue to Beit Shean and view the newly excavated ruins of this beautiful Roman-Byzantine City (Scythopolis). See the streets, public buildings and temples. Overnight in Jerusalem. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 6	❖ <b>Ein Karem, Bethlehem</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visit Ein Karem the birthplace of St. John the Baptist and the Church of Visitation. Continue to Bethlehem city of King David and place of the birth of Jesus. Visit the Shepherd's Field, and the grottos of the shepherds "And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. Mass to be celebrated at the Shepherds Field. Next we visit the Nativity Church, in the heart of Bethlehem marks one of Christianity's most sacred sites. The church is built over the grotto where the Virgin Mary gave birth to Jesus. Before returning to Jerusalem, visit the Garden Tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem. [B,D]</li> </ul>

DATE	DETAILS
DAY 7	<b>❖ JERUSALEM OUTSIDE OF THE WALLS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Today we visit the places outside of the old walls of Jerusalem; Mount of Olives, Chapels of Ascension, The Grotto of Lord's Prayer where He taught his disciples the Lord's Prayer, and the Garden of Gethsemane. We will celebrate Mass in the Basilica located on this site. Then on to the Tomb of the Virgin Mary, believed to be the burial place of Virgin Mary. Next we visit the most holy place for the Jewish people the Wailing Wall, Tomb of King David, Room of the Last Supper, Basilica of Dormision, Church of Saint Peter in Gallicantu, where Jesus was held prisoner. Overnight in Jerusalem. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 8	<b>❖ Masada, The Dead Sea</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Depart to the Desert of Judea to visit, Massada, the last stronghold of the Jews after the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 A.D. Afterwards, continue to the Dead Sea. On our way back to Bethlehem, we visit Qumran the place where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Overnight in Jerusalem. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 9	<b>❖ Israel (Allenby Bridge, Wadi Rum), Petra</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Board the bus as we travel on the Allenby Bridge to cross the border into Israel. Then continue to Wadi Rum, the largest ravine in Jordan and made famous through the movie called, Lawrence of Arabia. Experience a thrilling 4-wheel drive through the sand dunes and receive a keffiyeh, a local headscarf. Overnight in Petra. Evening at your leisure. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 10	<b>❖ Petra</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Once the ancient Nabatean capital, this city gently reveals itself as you walk through its hand carved facades. Starting at the visitors center, each person is assigned a guided horse that will lead you to the once hidden entrance to the lost city and travel through the SIQ, an immense crack in the Nubian sandstone. Near the end of the passage, appears Petra's most impressive monument, el Khazneh - The Treasury. This is one of the most elegant remains of antiquity, carved out of the solid rock from the side of the mountain and is nearly 140 feet high and 90 feet wide. Overnight in Petra. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 11	<b>❖ Kerak, Wadi Mujib, Dead Sea</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Travel to Kerak and explore the Kerak Castle and Wadi Mujib, the Jordanian Grand Canyon. Overnight at the Dead Sea. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 12	<b>❖ Madaba, Mount Nebo, Israel</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After breakfast travel to Mount Nebo, a short drive will bring you to visit Madaba, known as the City of Mosaics. Here you will visit the oldest map of the Holy Land on the floor of Saint George's Church. Next is Bethany Beyond the Jordan, where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. Overnight in Israel. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 13	<b>❖ Israel</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explore the city at your leisure. [B,D]</li> </ul>
DAY 14	Homeward bound. [B]
